Requirements

The CAA event organizer will assign 10' X 10' spaces. Artists must be 18 years or older and will provide their own display equipment (e.g., canopies, table, chairs, easels, card racks, etc.). All art must be created by the artist and for sale; no commercially manufactured items for sale will be allowed. CAA will collect no commission. All booths must be set up and ready for sales by 9:30 AM on Sat. morning (No set-up before Aug.15) and removed immediately after the show is over. The artists are responsible for their own booth signage. Artists must be present (no reps without artist) for the entire day (with reasonable breaks, of course). Artists are responsible for collecting their own sales tax on sales made at the event and remitting taxes collected to the state. Although it is not a requirement, artists are encouraged to provide each buyer with a receipt for purchased work; the artist must provide his/her own receipt book. Artists are responsible for cleaning up their spaces when the show is over as well as the area immediately around their spaces.

2. The City of Longview does not provide medical or accident insurance coverage and is not responsible for personal articles lost or stolen.
3. I allow photographs taken during City programs to be published without limitation for non-commercial purposes.
4. I agree to abide by and follow the activity and registration policies and procedures.

City of Longview Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release:

I am fully aware of the fact that there are special dangers and risks inherent in this activity, including, but not limited to the risk of serious physical injury, death or other harmful consequences that may arise or result directly or indirectly to me from my participation in this activity. Being fully informed as to these risks and in consideration of my being allowed to participate in City sponsored activities, I hereby assume all risk of injury, damage, liability and harm to myself arising from such activities. I also hereby individually and on behalf of my heirs, executors and assigns, release and hold harmless the City of Longview, their officials, employees and agents and waive any right of recovery that I might have to bring a claim or a lawsuit against them for any personal injury, death or other consequences occurring to me arising out of my voluntary participation in this activity, except for the sole negligence of the City of Longview.
